## **Trade Space Rates**

**Covered Marquee and Food Marquee:** £60.00 per stand (stand 10'X 10')

**Outdoor Space:** £50.00 for up to 10 foot frontage + £3.00 per foot frontage thereafter

(Stands are min. 20' deep)

Small stand: £50 (10' X10')

## **Guidelines for Trade Exhibitors**

These have been prepared with the Safety and well being of all participants and the general public in mind.

- 1. All exhibitors must make themselves familiar with the Safety Procedures Plan, which will be issued on arrival at the show.
- 2. All Entrance/Exits must be kept clear at all times.
- 3. As soon as you have set up your stand, a General Risk Assessment should be carried out (prior to opening to the general public) This is a simple procedure on which Show Safety Officers can give advice required by contacting the Show Office.
- 4. Exhibitors should ensure that all recognised safety standards and procedures are complied with.
- 5. All materials and Machinery must be on your allocated stand by 2.30pm on the Friday of the Show and remain there until after 4.00pm on the Saturday.
- 6. Subletting of space allocated by NAAA Ltd is forbidden.
- 7. The sale of Ice Cream, Drinks, Fast Food etc., is strictly confined to the Official Show Caterers any confusion/doubt on this rule should be cleared with the Show Secretary prior to booking the space.
- 8. The sale of objectionable articles such as toy guns, water pistols, stink bombs etc will not be permitted.
- 9. Exhibitors should not arrange their stand in such a manner as to inconvenience or disadvantageously affect the display of another exhibitor.
- 10. Exhibitors shall be responsible for the removal of refuse from their stand (bins & skip provided on site)
- 11. Exhibitors should ensure that they have relevant insurance in place for their exhibition.
