All cattle entered for this Show must be from OFFICIALLY TUBERCULOSIS FREE HERDS and each animal must be accompanied by the Official Movement Permit. ANIMALS WILL BE REFUSED ENTRY IF NOT ACCOMPANIED BY THE CORRECT PAPERWORK. Pre-movement testing for Bovine Brucellosis is no longer required for movement to shows.

Only those animals with a BVD status of BVDN (negative), INDNEG (indirect negative) or "blank" (no BVD status on APHIS) can move into the show herd. Any animal with an APHIS status BVDP, BVDI, DAMPI, OFFPI or BVDU (unknown) status cannot be moved into the show herd.

PLEASE NOTE ALL DRIVERS OUTSIDE A RADIUS OF 65KM MUST HAVE ANIMAL TRANSPORTER AUTHORISATION CERTIFICATE.

Exhibitors should ensure that all animals are adequately halter trained.

Note Dairy & Beef Interbreed classes don't start until 11.30am.

ALL PRIZE WINNERS MUST PARADE, OTHERWISE PRIZE MONEY WILL BE WITHHELD. CATTLE AND GOATS PARADE IN MAIN ARENA at 2.30 pm.

All Exhibitors wishing to qualify for this Championship must enter the name of their animal(s) at the qualifying Show. The 1st & 2nd placed exhibits in all Dairy Cow Classes at Ballymoney Show are eligible to go forward to the Thompson's Dairy Cow Qualifier, however if this does not include a "heifer in milk" (lactation 1) (Class 105) then the highest placed animal in this category should also go forward to the qualifier. Three animals will qualify per Show to include a maximum of 2 adult cows in milk (lactation 2+) and one heifer-in-milk cow (lactation 1). No exhibitor may qualify more than four exhibits for the Championship final. To maximise attendance of qualifying exhibits at the Championship, stewards will enquire if it is the intention of the exhibitor to be present at Antrim Show on Saturday, 26th July, 2025 for the Championship. In the event of qualified exhibitors not wishing to attend the Championship, then the Judge will be asked to identify further qualifying animals. Qualifying Exhibitors who do not appear at the Championship may be disqualified from competing in Championships organised by NISA in 2026, unless good reason is given for such non-appearance. THOMPSON'S will present special rosettes to the Exhibitors of qualifying animals at each qualifying show. Each animal forward at the Championship, which does not gain 1st to 6th place, will be paid a Thompsons's £50 Feed Voucher.
